

EMERGENCY RESOLUTIONS

Emergency Resolutions must be submitted to Provincial Council for consideration at their meeting the morning of Friday September 19th and will be considered by the Convention floor that afternoon.

Only resolutions passed by the **general membership** of a delegating body may be submitted to the General Policy Statements and Resolutions Committee (GPSRC) for consideration. The GPSRC is a Committee of the Provincial Executive. The criteria for these resolutions consist of the following:

- ▶ Does it fall within the purview of the Ontario NDP (is it a provincial issue)?
- ▶ Does policy related to the issue already exist within the Ontario NDP Policy book?
- ▶ Is it already addressed by resolutions submitted prior to the deadline of September 17?

Resolutions must be submitted electronically in Word or text format to councilrsvp@ontariondp.ca by **Wednesday, September 17th at 5:00 p.m. ET**. The GPSRC will not consider resolutions received after this deadline.

The GPSRC will meet in person on **Friday, September 19th, at 8:30 a.m. at the Niagara Falls Convention Centre in room 203** to deliberate. Movers of resolutions may attend the meeting to speak to these issues. The GPSRC will present its report during the Council plenary. Emergency Resolutions passed in the Council plenary will then go to the Convention floor during the first block of policy debate.
